MACDONALD SUITE

The MacDonald Suite has an abundance of natural light flooding in from the two walls of windows creating a bright and airy atmosphere that is sure to impress your guests. Set on the corner of the building you get great views down to the streets below with the privacy that your meeting and events deserve.

Did you know?

This suite is named after Frances Macdonald, who was born near Wolverhampton, but in 1890 her family moved to Glasgow. Frances and her older sister Margaret enrolled at Glasgow School of Art (GSA) and took drawing classes. By 1894 the Macdonald sisters had left GSA and established a studio where they made (often collaboratively) metalwork, embroideries, jewellery and craft items.

MACKINTOSH SUITE

The MacKintosh Suite on the first floor boasts an impressive full wall of windows, allowing for plenty of natural light to flood the space. Despite its smaller size, this versatile room is perfect for a variety of meetings and events. Whether you're hosting an intimate brainstorming session or a small training seminar, the MacKintosh Suite provides a comfortable and inviting atmosphere that is sure to inspire productivity and creativity.

Did you know?

This event suite is named after the second MacDonald sister Margaret who after their innovative work which was inspired by Celtic imagery, literature, symbolism, and folklore, married the architect and designer Charles MacKintosh becoming Margaret MacDonald MacKintosh. Her most well-known works are the gesso panels made for interiors designed with Charles, such as tearooms and private residences. Three of her most popular pieces are now on display in the Kelvingrove Museum in Glasgow.

MACNICOL SUITE

Our most centralised room to our break out space holding up to an impressive 40 guests at once. The MacNicol Suite is a spacious room with one large wall of windows to allow in the natural light and give views down to the street below. With its expansive layout and capacity to hold up to 40 guests, the MacNicol Suite is the perfect space for your next meeting or event.

Did you know?

Our MacNicol suite is named after Elizabeth MacNicol, known as Bessie, born in Glasgow in 1869. She was one of the few artists within the Glasgow Girls group who excelled at painting during her time at the Glasgow School of Art. Contributing almost annually to the Glasgow Institute of Fine Arts exhibitions from 1893 to 1904, she began to attract attention and in 1896 opened her first studio at 175 St Vincent Street. Her one solo exhibition was held at Stephen Gooden's Art Rooms in Glasgow in 1899.

DEAN AND NEWBERY SUITE

The Dean and Newbery Suite is the perfect choice for those seeking a spacious and versatile space for their next meeting or event. With its impressive size, this suite can easily accommodate large groups while still maintaining a comfortable and welcoming atmosphere. The abundance of natural light that floods the room through its expansive windows creates a bright and airy ambiance that is sure to inspire creativity and productivity.

Did you know?

Our largest meeting room takes its name from two influential people in our city. Stansmore Dean was born in Glasgow, from 1883 Dean attended classes at the Glasgow School of Art. A turning point for the artist came in 1890 when she was awarded the Haldane Travelling Scholarship – the first woman to receive the prize – which enabled her to study in Paris.

Jessie Newbery was an artist and embroider in Glasgow, she created the department of embroidery at the Glasgow school of Art. She was an enthusiastic teacher and encouraged a strong sense of design in her pupils' work. She opened the doors to women students with a generous admission policy and a reformed curriculum.

Parking
